We have accomplished a lot since the start of this policy, and we plan to continue to enhance our systems. The main areas of focus are in energy consumption, paper reduction, and recycling.

Accomplishments

Energy Consumption
Changed all lighting in warehouse and offices to High Efficiency Lighting
Installed sensor lighting at 315 office
Installed sensor lighting in some areas of warehouse

Paper Reduction

Introduced electronic invoicing. Have currently reduced paper invoicing by 80%

Recycling

Created program to recycle, cardboard, paper, and plastic from both warehouse and office

Future Goals

Prinova plans to reduce energy consumption by 5% over the next 5 years.

This will be accomplished by installing more sensor lighting and installing air curtains on the dock doors, and upgrading our HVAC system.

Prinova plans to reduce paper consumption by 30% over the next 5 years.

This will be accomplished by promoting paper conservation, and increasing access to less waste printing options.

Prinova plans to improve our collection of recyclable waste.
